



## JUST SO YOU KNOW...

- Do not have the mind-set that you know where you are going unless you have been here before. Use your GPS or Google maps as a guideline. Some people have experienced that certain maps take them across the river. If you are coming from East London side the dirt road should take you about 1 hour. Travelling from Durban side the dirt road should take you about 1 and a half hours. Road conditions change due to rain etc. A 4 x 4 is recommended especially if you want to explore a larger area while you here. A normal 2 x 4 vehicle with high clearance is recommended otherwise. Go slow, check for people and animals and enjoy the scenery. It is best to arrive during daylight hours
- We recommend that you only make use of services provided by our staff or recommended hawkers and only outside or over the fence...we have dogs. Please do not invite any of the locals onto the property for a visit.
- Don't leave your bait and tackle lying around. Our dogs are local hunting dogs and can sniff out anything from anywhere. A fish hook stuck down a dog's throat is not a good thing.
- When moving or driving your vehicle, please always check for children and animals first.
- If you have dogs, please check if it is fine to bring them along before arrival. Please make sure they are kept under control. You will be held responsible and liable should your dog hunt / kill livestock. Unfortunately we won't be able to assist or get you out of this one.
- No crayfish out of season (1 November – 1 March)
- Don't throw sweets out your car window or just dish them out on the side of the road. It's only encouraging the local kids to beg and there are no dentists in the rural areas. If you do want to gift the kids bring along some stationery or toys.
- **Use water sparingly**
- We ONLY rely on harvesting rain water. Please prep your family or group on saving water. There is no municipal infrastructure or water supply.
- Please advise us should you require your room to be serviced. Generally staff only maintain the kitchen area, ablutions, braai and gardens.
- Please try and limit your refuse and use of non-refundable bottles.
- **TAKE NOTE : Babies & Toddlers- We do not have a disposal facility for disposable diapers. Should you make use of disposables, please make sure to bring along a diaper bin or bag which can be kept in your room and taken with you on departure. We apologise for the inconvenience, but there is no other way around this issue.**
- We suggest you bring your own firewood / charcoal. A lot of the wood sold locally are mostly indigenous trees from the forest.
